The opportunity for business growth in the Texas Innovation Corridor is simply unmatched.





In fiscal year 2022, the Greater San Marcos Partnership closed on **9 new company announcements**, including the first-ever \$1 billion announcement in our region, the first-ever one-million-square-foot industrial facility in Caldwell County and the first-ever one-million-square-foot speculative industrial facility in Hays County.

Additionally, GSMP's efforts secured more than 2,500 new jobs with \$2 billion in capital investment, more than \$284 million in new tax base revenue for the public sector, and mostly importantly, developed a record-setting \$140 billion prospect pipeline. This is more than double the entire pipeline of GSMP's history combined.

More than 30 major companies have selected the Texas Innovation Corridor since 2020, not including the many future employers who are

now considering our two-county region as their future home. Projects now consistently come in with multi-billion dollar capital expenditures and thousands of jobs per project, giving a preview of our region's future opportunities.

This compounding success is only possible because of the incredible business community we have in Hays and Caldwell Counties. No other place in the country has the same engaged effort as our footprint's public and private partners, workforce developers, business leaders, economic developers and volunteers who work together create the best place in the country to do business. We thank each and every one of them who make these results possible.

Quality growth is here to stay, and GSMP is excited to bring even more economic prosperity to the Texas Innovation Corridor.



With our regional partners, GSMP helped 102 local, already-established businesses in this fiscal year.

By conducting both business support visits and business retention & expansion visits, GSMP collected data on trends such as workforce needs and business growth issues, proactively connected business leaders to needed resources, and helped cultivate the growth of the Texas Innovation Corridor.

Thanks to these visits, 10 companies in Hays and Caldwell Counties are now in the process of an expansion in the Texas Innovation Corridor.



Small Business Initiatives

In FY 2022, GSMP conducted four small business trainings this year, covering topics such as cybersecurity, small business financial health and succession planning. (pictured right) Approximately 80 small business owners attended these trainings.

GSMP also developed a connection between Skillpoint Alliance and manufacturers in the Texas Innovation Corridor. Skillpoint Alliance, a leader in workforce development, was awarded the Texas Talent Connection Grant to offer their Certified Production Technician training program, which



significantly increases the manufacturing workforce pipeline in Hays and Caldwell Counties. Classes for this certification will begin in October 2022.
