#### Role in Texas Innovation Corridor Familiarization Tour

During the **Texas Innovation Corridor Familiarization Tour**, six nationally leading site selectors toured Hays and Caldwell Counties to learn of the business opportunities in the region and quality of life found in the region, particularly in the beauty of Wimberley.

As part of this event, the City of Wimberley played an active role to promote Wimberley's culture, its locally owned businesses in the downtown district, and the tourism opportunities in the city. The City Manager of Wimberley, Michael Boese, also played an active role in leading discussions during the City Manager roundtable and representing Wimberley at the opening community presentations.

#### Key Achievements in Wimberley in FY 2022

- ★ In GSMP's internationally award-winning Economic Development Week campaign, Wimberley served as the cornerstone of the Quality of Life video, highlighting Wimberley's downtown district and businesses such as Bent Tree Art Gallery, The Wildflower, Old Mill Store and Candy Cottage.
- ★ GSMP, in collaboration with Watershed Partners and Siglo Group, developed a Decision Support Tool survey to promote conservation of water and greenbelts in economic development efforts.
- GSMP partnered with PeopleFund to provide financial planning services to seven local businesses in Wimberley, all of which received COVID relief funds through the Hays County ECAP program, which GSMP administered.
- ★ GSMP collaborated with the Wimberley Valley Chamber of Commerce during the Business Booster Series, a series of business development workshops strengthening more than 25 local businesses in Hays County on topics such as brand marketing, LinkedIn advertising, customer service and operations security.
- ★ GSMP played an active role as a member of the Wimberley Valley Chamber of Commerce, sponsoring Chamber networking lunches & local business events.
